

Applying Flea Treatment to Skittish Kitties

Just sharing a tip/trick we learned early on that makes applying monthly topical flea treatment a bit easier for those hard-to-get kitties. You know, the ones who might only let you pet them for a split second before darting away or maybe they won't let you pet them, but they'll eat right next to you.

Putting the topical flea treatment on these types of kitties is impossible with that little tube. You pretty much have to be able to touch them to get the tube close to their skin, as well as have them hold still for several seconds since it takes a couple of squirts to apply the full dose....NO WAY!! Right??

What we do is squirt the solution into one of these syringes to apply the flea treatment.

It's pretty much a one & done squirt, & since the syringe is longer your hands don't have to touch kitty, & because the plunger slides easily it's also quick. Sure, sometimes kitty is still fast enough to get away & doesn't get the full dose, but in those instances "some" is better than none. With practice, though, it really does make it easier to apply the monthly flea treatment.

Hope this might be useful for anyone who cares for skittish kitties.
